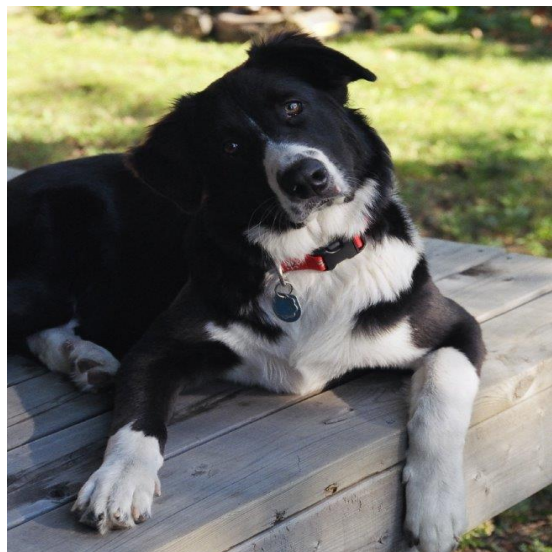

A license is a dog's ticket home!

What are the benefits?

There are many benefits of licensing your dog with the City of Sault Ste. Marie Animal Care & Control Services. Your dog's license is his ticket home. If he or she is ever lost, his licence provides Animal Care & Control with critical information that will help us return him/her to you safely. In fact, pet licensing has been proven to result in high return to owner rates which eliminates euthanasia of adoptable pets. Other benefits:

- Dog licenses that are purchased voluntarily are eligible for the Free Ride Program,
- Use of Strathclair Dog Park
- Peace of mind in the event of an emergency. First responders rely on us to house & reunite pets.

Free Ride Program

Stray or lost dogs who are wearing a current City dog tag that was purchased voluntarily will be reunited with their owner free of charge. A free ride can be applied once in a calendar year.



What is a dog license?

A dog license is issued when you register your dog with the City of Sault Ste. Marie. A dog tag with a unique number is provided and is to be attached to your dog's collar. This tag number is linked to your contact information in our database.

Is it really needed?

The city of Sault Ste. Marie by-law 98-211 requires that all dogs be registered by purchasing a city dog license every calendar year. A current rabies vaccine certificate is required to purchase a license. Dogs who come into the pound that are not licensed may be subject to a Provincial Offences fine.

How is licensing revenue spent?

As the operator of the City Pound for Sault Ste. Marie we are the authorized agent for issuing City dog licenses. All revenue stays at the shelter and allows us to:

- Reunite lost cats and dogs with their owner's
- Shelter and feed lost cats and dogs
- Educate cat and dog owners about responsible pet ownership
- Manage our adoption program
- Resolve animal related conflicts
- Assist emergency first responders and other social agencies with animal concerns.
- Provide emergency services for injured animals.

How much does it cost?

\$10 spayed/neutered/microchipped
\$20 spayed/neutered
\$50 unaltered

How can I purchase my dog license?

You can purchase a dog license at the shelter, by mail or online on our website.

What are your hours of operation?

We are open seven days a week and have a 24 hour Emergency Service. Office hours:
