Thank you for your interest in volunteering with us at the Humane Society! Volunteers are highly-valued members of our team, and we welcome new volunteers throughout the year. Please read the following instructions and ensure you have filled out this application completely. You may bring a paper copy into the shelter, or email to ssmhsvolunteer@shaw.ca

- Basic Requirements for Volunteers:
 - Volunteers must be able to commit to a minimum term of one year. We need at least 1-2 hours per week to ensure consistency for the animals. (You will work with our volunteer coordinator for your schedule.)
 - o Volunteers must be at least 18 years old to handle dogs.
 - Volunteers must be at least 16 years old to handle cats and critters.
 - High School students completing community service hours must be 16 years of age, and may only handle cats or critters.
 - Volunteers must be able to work safely around animals

- Recognize that my services are provided strictly in a voluntary capacity, with no compensation, salary, employee benefits, employment insurance, workers compensation, or payment of any kind
- Agree not to represent the Humane Society outside of my capacity as a volunteer
- Agree to be present for scheduled shifts and to carry out duties promptly and reliably
- Agree to familiarize myself and comply with the Humane Society's policies and procedures
- Agree to hold absolutely confidential all information that may be obtained, directly or indirectly, concerning clients, animals, and staff. I agree not to seek to obtain confidential information from clients or others
- Agree to waive on behalf of myself, my heirs, administrators and assigns, to be deemed
 to have waived, any and all claims against the Sault Ste. Marie & District Humane
 Society, its officers, employees, or agents from any all liability, including claims for
 damage, injury, or loss of earnings as a result of injury or accident in connection with
 volunteering. Further I indemnify and save the Sault Ste. Marie & District Humane
 Society, its officers, employees, and agents from any and all liability insured by any or all
 of them, whether resulting from this contract of a breach thereof of my volunteer work.
